President's Corner

Thank you all for your patience during our road construction season. If I sent an individual thank you card to match the size of your patience, it wouldn't fit into a mailbox. Many of the streets have been completed so far, but there are others that are just getting started.

The weather has played a huge factor in completing the Year One projects, so we hope that the weather this fall will be more accommodating. As winter approaches, our engineers will be surveying the roads for Year Two road remediation that will begin next spring.

In addition to the work on the west side of the tollway, you may have noticed the construction on the 35 acre business park across from Lamb's Farm. Presently Panattoni Builders are constructing a large office, warehouse, and distribution center. The first tenant is North Shore Care Supply who sells diapers for children, adults, and pets worldwide. The owners are local people who are excited to have a new business in Green Oaks. They will employ about 50 people and will provide sales tax revenues for the Village.

The new roads, sewer, and water lines have been installed in the business park and first occupancy should occur at the beginning of 2020. We still will need your patience as we expand the intersection at Route 176 and Bradley Rd.

One other project that has taken a long time to start is the Atkinson Rd timber bridge. In 2014, we submitted a grant request with IDOT for replacing the old timber bridge east of the tollway. We were approved, but funding was not forthcoming from the state. Finally phase one engineering has been "accepted" and bidding of the job should begin in July, 2020.

Finally, there has been a great deal written regarding municipal cannabis business zoning. In June, 2019, Governor Pritzker signed the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act. The Act legalized consumption and possession of cannabis in Illinois for residents over 21 years of age. The Act also provides for a state license and regulation of cannabis business establishments.

Under the law, Illinois cities and villages may prohibit cannabis business establishments from locating in their jurisdiction by adoption of a local ordinance. The Village did pass an ordinance prohibiting adult-use cannabis business establishments in our community. Various towns in Lake County that are permitting a cannabis business establishment may begin sale in 2020.

Hopefully we will have good weather this fall to complete and/or start our many projects.

The Building Department is responsible for identifying businesses within the Village to determine if they are in compliance with our zoning ordinances. Additionally, we continuously work with current and future business owners in securing proper business licenses, and with the Fire Department to make sure all companies procure a safe operating environment for them and the community.

The Village Board has recently voted NOT to allow the retail / wholesale businesses of Cannabis dispensaries or farming in the Village. The available areas for these prospective businesses are not in the best interests of our Village as they are close to schools and residential areas.

Winter is coming soon and fall cleaning is starting. Please be aware that parking and storage of trailers, campers, and motor homes in driveways are prohibited.

Please consider these tips when preparing your property for winter:

- Keep wood piles away from the exterior of your home to reduce rodent infestation.
- Trim & clean bushes, trees, and debris close to your home.
- Make certain sump pump discharge lines are at least 10-15 feet from your home.
- Clean / cut any debris from ditches for spring rains.
- Check and clean gutters for debris.
- Pick up or place all leaves to the street for fall pick up (see dates in this Newsletter).

As we enjoy the benefits of our new roads recently installed (40% complete by end of the year with the remaining 60% to be done in the near future), we have to remind ourselves that winter is quickly approaching. Soon enough we'll have to deal with snow and snow plowing matters (but at least this year the Bears are doing better):

- All Village streets will be plowed when accumulation is greater than 1".
- Major intersections will be salted during a plow event.
- In the event of icy conditions, neighborhoods & side streets will be salted.
- Mailboxes that inadvertently get damaged by the contractor:
 - Will be repaired or replaced with a temporary mailbox until weather permits to allow for permanent solution.
 - Will be permanently repaired, usually in spring, with a new mailbox of contractor's choice, installed by contractor. Or, you can request a \$50 reimbursement.
 - Should be reported to the Village within 5 (five) days of damage.
- Clear your sidewalk. This is especially helpful for children trying to get to school or for packages/mail delivered safely.
- Consider helping senior citizens and handicapped who live nearby by shoveling their sidewalks.
- When clearing your driveway, shovel or blow the snow onto the parkway to the right side of your driveway as you face the street. DO NOT deposit on your neighbor's property.
- Park vehicles off the street.
- Make sure your mailbox is 12 inches from the curb and that the post is secure.
- Adopt a fire hydrant and keep it clear of snow. It's there to protect you.
- Please stay clear of street while shoveling or snow blowing your driveway if you see a plow or any traffic. The safety and well being of our community is our number one priority.
- If your property has difficult or blind areas that a snow plow driver may not be aware of, please consider placing temporary stakes in the areas of concern to help alleviate any possible damage that may occur. The best time to do this is in early December.

As always, please let me know if there are areas that need more attention from the Village.

Effects of Salt Deicers

Winter isn't here just yet, but this copy of The Oak Leaf extends into the holiday winter season. Salt does an amazing job melting ice and making our roads safe during the winter months. However, excessive salt usage can have a negative impact as well. The Village works to reduce its salt usage annually to minimize the impact to the environment.

Overuse can:

- Contaminate waterways
- Kill landscaping
- Damage uncured concrete
- Cause illness if ingested by children or pets

Nothing works better at preventing ice buildup than proper snow removal after a storm. Removing the snow from hard surfaces prevents the freeze-thaw cycle that ultimately freezes over. If salting is performed, the best way to apply salt is to do so before the storm. Pre-salting creates a brine, or barrier, that prevents bonding to the pavement and reduces freezing and accumulation. If salt is used, only apply at or below the application rates identified on packaging and sweep up extra salt once things have dried out. The snow is gone and any remaining salt will only hurt the environment.

Consider finding alternative products that are pet friendly. Road salt can cause painful burning and cracked or dried out pads in your pet. Alternative products can even be more effective in lower temperatures. We all need to work together to reduce chloride use which in turn will help protect the environment.

Fire Safety Message

Now that Fall is here, as homeowners, we start the annual ritual to prepare for winter. This ritual often includes cleaning gutters, raking leaves, replacing smoke and carbon monoxide detector batteries, starting the snowblower as well as the many other tasks that will help get us through the snow and cold. Another Fall ritual is "Fire Prevention Week". This year Fire Prevention Week was October 6th through the 12th. Every year, a new safety message is taught during Fire Prevention Week to educate the community on Fire Safety. This year, the message is "Not Everyone Wears a Cape. Plan and Practice Your Escape". This is an important message for families to practice getting out of your home in the event of a fire. Practicing your escape can save precious seconds should a real emergency occur.

Some additional safety reminders include making sure your Smoke Detectors and Carbon Monoxide detectors are in working order and have new batteries installed. Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detectors must be installed on each floor of your home and within ten feet of a sleeping area. People tend to assume that simply having smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors in their home ensures adequate protection from fires and carbon monoxide poisoning. It takes regular testing and maintenance to ensure that this is the case. Part of that effort is making sure you know how old the smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors are in your home, and that they are replaced every 10 years. The age of a smoke detector can be determined by looking for the date of manufacture on the back or side of the alarm, and to replace the units 10 years from that date.

Another recommended winter preparation is to have your fireplace chimney inspected and cleaned. Chimney fires are real and can cause severe damage to your home. Contact a reputable and insured chimney sweep to have your chimney inspected before it gets cold.

What makes the Village Administrative Office of Green Oaks so unique is the special people who come to work every day and get the opportunity to make a difference in the lives of others.

Most of us begin our day simply by turning the water on and we don't think of how our Village is working for us at that very moment. Green Oaks works collectively with the City of Waukegan and Lake County Public Works to ensure that the best water and waste water service are allocated to our residents and business owners. The Village Administrative Office manages the billing and receipt of all payment(s) for residents with water, sewer and sewer maintenance services. Call anytime Monday thru Friday 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. at 847-362-5363 with any questions or concerns, Caitlin, Elke, Julie, Lisa and I are happy to assist you.

Building Department Services are contracted through R Professional Group. Rich Politowicz is the Building Commissioner and has office hours at Village Hall Monday and Wednesday from 11 a.m. to 12 p.m. All Permit Applications may be obtained at the Village Hall Monday thru Friday 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. or by simply downloading an application from our website at greenoaks.org. Since January the Building Department has issued 170 Permits with a collective Estimated Cost of Construction Permitted of \$15,002,342.

Getting to the end of the day many residents look forward to coming home and taking a healthy walk around the neighborhood. Pothole repair and maintenance throughout the Village is supported by Marty Neal and Mike Zorn of the Libertyville Township Highway Department. Please call the Administrative Office and notify us of any roadway concerns.

It is the consensus of many that it's NOT preferred to see what your neighbor's four legged family member left behind for you to see...So at this time having some baggage is a good thing.. Let's be considerate of our neighbor's property and the community, and carry a "doggie bag" and kindly dispose of it in your own waste container.

Since January we have had the pleasure of welcoming 39 new residents to Green Oaks! The Village Board has passed 17 Ordinances, 10 Resolutions and 1 Proclamation. These last three months have been highlighted by securing a \$3.5M bond necessary to carry out the current Village Road Improvement Project, of which this year's goal has an estimated target completion date of November, weather permitting. With the Village's Triple-A (AAA) credit rating it holds itself in a great position for the upcoming \$4M TIF bond. On July 24th the Village Board passed the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year commencing the 1st day of May, 2019 and ending the 30th day of April, 2020. On September 25th the Village Board also approved the Annual Financial Report for Year Ended April 30, 2019. Finally, with Illinois becoming the latest state in the nation to legalize marijuana, the Village Board approved an Ordinance, on August 28th amending the municipal code with the addition of a new Chapter 6 to Title 13 Prohibiting Cannabis Business Establishments.

The Green Oaks Business Park has been full of zip with trucks, dirt and lots of activity bringing attention to the recent development of new public works/utility infrastructure and road/building construction. The Village has approved three new street names: North Bradley Road, Confidence Drive and Tomei Street. Panattoni's new tenant is North Shore Care Supply now located at 1 Confidence Drive. North Shore Care Supply is an adult/pet diaper supplier and anticipates occupancy in early January 2020.

These are just a few instances of how we get to humbly serve the Residents and Business Owners of the Village of Green Oaks and how very fortunate we are to call Green Oaks our HOME. Simply put...

Green Oaks is a great place to live, work and raise a family!

Saturdays Only: October 19th - November 30th

On the night before, or by 6:00 a.m. on the day of the pick-up, rake your leaves to the edge of the roadway where disposal trucks will vacuum them away. **DO NOT BAG THE LEAVES.** To ensure maximum drainage during the winter and spring, clear the leaves and debris from all culverts and roadside ditches on your property.

United States Census 2020

WHAT IS THE CENSUS?

As mandated by the U.S. Constitution, our nation gets just one chance each decade to count its population. Yes, that's YOU! The 2020 Census will count the population in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and five U.S. territories (Puerto Rico, American Samoa, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, Guam, and the U.S. Virgin Islands).

WHO EXECUTES THE CENSUS?

The U.S. Census is conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau, a nonpartisan government agency. Your privacy is protected. It is against the law for the Census Bureau to publicly release your responses in any way that could identify you or your household. By law, the Census Bureau cannot share your answers with any other government agency. The Bureau will never ask you for:

- Your Social Security number
- Money or donations
- Anything on behalf of a political party
- Your bank or credit card account numbers

WHY IS THE CENSUS EXECUTED?

Federal funds, grants and support to states, counties and communities are based on population totals and breakdowns by sex, age, race and other factors. Our community benefits the most when the census counts everyone. When you respond to the census, you help our community get its fair share of the more than \$675 billion per year in federal funds allocated to schools, hospitals, roads, public works and other vital programs.

Businesses use census data to decide where to build factories, offices and stores, and this creates jobs. Developers use the census to build new homes and revitalize old neighborhoods. Local governments use the census for public safety and emergency preparedness. Residents use the census to support community initiatives involving legislation, quality-of-life and consumer advocacy.

After each decade's census, state officials redraw the boundaries of the congressional and state legislative districts in their states to account for population shifts and determine how many seats each state gets in the House of Representatives.

HOW IS THE CENSUS EXECUTED?

Every home will receive an invitation to participate in the 2020 Census by either a postal worker (95%) or a census worker (5%, reserved for households that use P.O. boxes or areas recently affected by natural disasters).

You will have three options for responding

- Online
- By phone
- By mail

The 2020 Census marks the first time you'll have the option to respond online. You can even respond on your mobile device.


