

Village of Green Oaks LSL Inventory and Lead and Copper Sampling

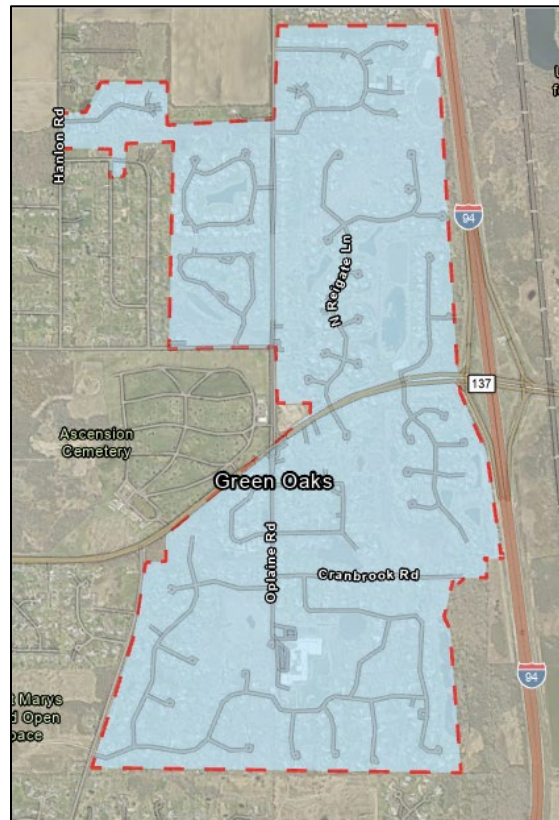
The Village completed and submitted its lead service line inventory to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA). No lead service lines were found and the IEPA accepted the Village's inventory in August 2026. The Village would like to thank all residents that aided the Village in completing the lead service line inventory. The Village is now addressing the updated lead and copper sampling requirements. In accordance with IEPA requirements, the Village is required to sample a portion of their water customers to determine lead and copper levels in the water. The approximate limits of the Village's water system are shown below – note that this is their overall service area, and there are lots within the shading that may not be connected to water or have watermain along the frontage of their property. Samples will be collected two times in 2026, and then every six months going forward, for a total of two samples per year.

For each sampling event, water customers will fill a Village provided 1000 mL sample bottle from their tap. The Village will collect the sample for testing and provide testing result to the water customer. The Village has not received any positive tests for lead in their drinking water. The activities the Village is undertaking are required by the IEPA and are precautionary.

There are other portions of the Village on public water, but the water system is owned and operated by Lake County Public Works Department. They manage and operate the system independently of the Village.
